

Update on the Street Party Review for discussion at 11<sup>th</sup> Oct Parish Council Meeting.

1. Firstly if you have read the feedback emails and the review meeting minutes you will know that we met our objectives with this event and the vast majority of the parish thoroughly enjoyed themselves. People who I don't know are still stopping me and thanking the Parish Council for all the work that went into making it happen.
2. The review meeting did look at those few negative comments that came forward and came up with suggestions for amendment should the event happen again or accepted the comments were made by people who did not understand the objectives behind the grant.
3. I have now submitted the review document to the East Riding, Stating:
  - The success of the project and providing the evidence of the objectives having been met
  - Stating the spend is £1162 which is an underspend of £642.50
  - This underspend we have requested the following:
    - a. reimburse toddlers for the face painter of £190.
    - b. Fund a Christmas event – tree, lights, mulled wine and mince pies
4. The remaining food and accessories have been split between The Peoples Pantry and the Church. The church have two events coming up the Pudding and Punch event this weekend when the paper plates and serviettes will be used and the Christmas Bazaar when the Sausages and burgers will be used.
5. We raised in the collection boxes and the stalls takings, £1091.50. The proposal from the review meeting is to split this as follows:

Toddlers	- £250.00
Hall	- £91.50 from craft group
Church	- £400.00 to inc £91.50 from craft group
PTA	- £250.00
Netball	-£100.00
