Minutes to the Meeting of Bishop Wilton Parish Council, held on Thursday 23rd May 2024 at 7.00pm directly after the Annual Meeting, at Bishop Wilton Village Hall.

The chairman welcomed members and guests and advised that the meeting was being recorded in line with Parish Council protocol.

To consider co-option of a new councillor – two expressions of interests have been received, both from residents living outside the parish but only one within the boundaries for becoming a councillor. It was proposed by Cllr Rigby and seconded by Cllr Warry that Gavin Lonsdale be co-opted as a councillor for Bishop Wilton Parish Council Resolved.

480. Ward Councillors Report and outstanding issues - Cllr Hammond advised that the devolution deal had been ratified. The pot holes on Braygate and Belthorpe Lane have been

filled. The pot holes on Park Lane to be pursued. The issues with Vicarage Lane to be discussed with ERYC as it is a public bridleway so needs to be usable by pedestrians and horse riders.

482. Community Issues for consideration and resolution

- a. Trees/hedges bordering onto the beck-side Cllr Warry has again spoken to the key landowner of the 3 gardens bordering onto the beckside who are now to contact BT to see if they will cut back trees, which are now in full leaf and the shading issue is quite considerable. The information received from land registry, gave no clarification as to ownership of the trees, which although suffering from ash die back still have plenty of life.
- b. Cutting of Beckside contractor has done the first cut, but worked around the area of bulbs— to put on next months agenda as management of the village green.
- c. Spraying of butterbur budgeted for 2 cuts at £300 per cut to find qualified contractor defer until the next meeting
- d. Cutting of grass verge at the crossroads coming into the village from Pocklington now cut
- e. Issues at Vicarage Lane and damage to the bridlepath to monitor, see by Ward Cllrs report
